Foundation Stage Profile (End of Reception)

This data shows the % of children who met the required standard (Good Level of Development – GLD) by the end of Early Years in all the prime areas (Communication and Language; Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Physical Development) and Literacy and Mathematics. It is a measure of attainment, not progress. These percentages change year on year according to the cohort of children.

Phonics (End of Y1)

This national test is administered in June. It tests the phonic knowledge of children, their ability to decode and read words, not their understanding. Children who do not reach the required pass mark are re-tested at the end of Year 2.

Key Stage 2 (Year 6)

Key Stage 2 assessment is a judgement as to whether children are working at the Expected Standard (EXS) or not. This includes a scaled score, comparing our school with all schools nationally. A scaled score of 100 is needed to reach EXS.

The reading, grammar and maths tests are marked externally. Writing is assessed by the teacher and moderated. In 2024 this data was moderated by the Local Authority (this happens on a regular basis for all schools).
